The neurologist manages neurological complications of patients undergoing organ transplants and complex surgeries (cardiac, thoracic, and abdominal surgery) and patients affected with end-stage vital organ diseases. The neurologist is also responsible for pre-op assessment of patients affected with neurological comorbidities and candidates for surgery, for purposes of pre-operative risk stratification and peri-operative management. He/she is also responsible for conducting clinical and translational research projects, and performing an ongoing critical review of the accomplished outcomes.

Requisites:

- Degree in Medicine and Surgery recognized in Italy, or equivalent title
- Postgraduate diploma in Neurology recognized in Italy or equivalent title (already obtained or to be obtained during the current year)
- Enrollment in the professional board

Preferred qualifications:

- Documented professional experience in the position offered in this call for applications
- Scientific production rated with the H-index
- Excellent knowledge of English

Other requisites: Good knowledge of the main computer applications, willingness to spend periods of training abroad, strong motivation, flexibility, stress management, problem-solving, communication, interpersonal relationship, and teamwork skills.

The contract offered will be commensurate with the experience and skills of the selected candidate.

The deadline to submit applications is **November 4, 2019**.

Under penalty of exclusion, at the request of UPMC Italy at any time during the selection process and within the mandatory deadline, applicants must provide evidence of the requisites stated in their self-declaration. Should any preliminary verification show a discrepancy with any statement submitted by the applicant, the latter will be excluded from the selection process, and any negotiation deemed permanently suspended.
